PRE-GAME

- Optional: create a Match Day Roster with only the players and coaches attending. This will correctly populate the Match Card.
- BOTH TEAMS print the Match Card on Friday. Verify all players are listed.
- BOTH TEAMS bring a printed Match Card and all passes to the game.

CHECK-IN

PLAYERS MAY NOT BE WRITTEN ONTO THE MATCH CARD

- Home team presents printed Match Card (unless the Away team's is more recent).
- BOTH teams cross off players in excess of the maximum allowed.
- BOTH teams present coach and player passes (laminated or virtual).
- Identify anyone serving a red card and mark them on the Match Card.

POST-GAME

- Verify score and sign Match Card.
- BOTH Managers or Coaches take a photo of the Match Card for records.
- Retrieve passes and clean up bench.
- Score & Red Card Reporting:
 - Home team enters score within 24 hours.
 - Home team uploads Match Card.
 - Teams self-report any red cards through the score entry.

DIGITAL CHECK-IN

GotSport Live Digital Check-in is active and allowed.

- Create a game day roster.
- Access the match QR Code for referee check-in.
- Create a post-game report including score and any red cards.

If a referee checks in more than the eligible amount, it is the COACH'S responsibility to correct this. Playing more than the eligible per game is an automatic Forfeit.

SERVING RED CARDS

Coaches are responsible for making sure players serve their red cards. Players do not need to attend the game. Mark the match card to show they are serving. Coaches must not attend the game for which they are serving. Red Card fines must be paid by the recipient or the club before returning to play.

SPECTATOR CONDUCT

Parents/Spectators ARE NOT allowed to step onto the field unless specifically asked due to injury.
The coach is responsible for sideline behavior and must speak to unruly parents as needed.
